Dear Ms Vickery

I refer to your email dated 28 March 2017 to the Commissioner of Corrective Services about inmate Tony Liristis (MIN 361433) requesting he be given access to a laptop computer and various other issues. The Commissioner has asked me to respond on his behalf.

In accordance with Corrective Services NSW policy, Mr Liristis continues to have access to a number of electronic devices and methods of communication. These include access to telephone, computers, USB storage devices, faxes, printing and personal and legal visits. The issues you have raised in your letter regarding sending emails to a court from John Morony Correctional Centre (John Morony), and asking that Mr Liristis be allowed to sign out a USB stick have been addressed directly with him by Centre management.

Any emails or facsimiles received from a court or legal practitioner, which are intended for Mr Liristis, will be provided to him.

I can advise Mr Liristis has been approved to hold two tubs of legal paperwork in his cell at any one time while housed at John Morony.

With regard to access to a laptop computer, Mr Liristis has previously been advised that he is not permitted access to a laptop computer in his cell.
