

INMATE NOTICE

For information of all inmates at Long Bay Hospital

On 2 April 2008, there will be a change to the daily routine. This will affect the amount of time you spend out of your cells.

We are making these changes to get you used to the new routine when we move to the new hospital.

The new routine will mean that you will be let go at about 8.15am and then return to your cells for 30 minutes between the hours of 12.00 and 12.30.

At 12.30 you will be let out to have your lunch and then at 3.45 you will be locked back into your cells.

Your cells will only be open to enable medical staff to assist you with medical treatment and medications.

At around 6.30pm your meals will be brought to your cells and you will have your meal in your cell.

At around 8.30 you will be given a hot beverage in your cell.

Although the daily routine will be different, Justice Health staff and custodial staff will be working together to provide the best outcome.

More information about the move to the new hospital will be made available closer to the date.
